Official Rules

Here's How To Enter: Drop your registration form off to the Library or The Pie Place. The last day to register will be on 10/17/11.

Theme: The theme of the contest is "Happy Halloween". Please give your cake a title which will be displayed with the entry on the table. Please **do not** put your name on the cake as judging will be anonymous. Remember kids of all ages will be in this contest so please do not get too gross or scary with your cakes!

Cake Requirements: The cake submitted must be completely edible with the exception of separator plates, pillars, cake boards and support dowel rods including lollipop sticks. Cakes must be a minimum of 2" in diameter and a maximum base cake of 12" in width. It can be a tiered or non-tiered cake. The entrant must do all work on the cake only. Parents must help younger children with baking the cake but **the child must do icing and decorating alone**. Please take care in making any cakes that will be participating in the silent auction, as others will consume them.

Judging: All entries must be brought completed to the Peters Township Public Library multi-purpose room between 6:30pm and 7:00pm to be set-up for judging. Judging will judge at 7:00pm. There will be voting boxes for anyone in attendance to vote for the "people's choice award" between 7:15pm and 8:00. All awards will be given out at 8:00pm followed by the silent auction winners. A panel of local residents and business owners will judge cakes in each division.

General Rules: This contest is open to all that would like to participate. By participating in this contest, entrants (or parent/legal guardian if entrant is a minor) agree to be bound by the Official Rules and the decisions of the judges which are final.

Winners: Winners will be announced at the end of the event and their names and cake photos will be posted on The Pie Place website and in local media.

Prizes: First and Second place winners will receive an award and a prize. People's Choice winner will receive an award and a prize. Prizes furnished by **The Pie Pace, Upper St. Clair**.
